Thank you for your email response to my letter dated 28<sup>th</sup> June 2013 stating you would be happy to meet with myself and members of the Long Live Southbank campaign following meetings you have held regarding the design of Hungerford Bridge which we were not privy to.

As you will recall from our meeting held at Southbank Centre between LLSB, Mike McCart and yourself on the 12<sup>th</sup> June 2013, you had agreed to present our campaign and request for the Undercroft to remain in its present location to the Board of Governors of the Southbank Centre.

Mike McCart informed me in person at the public meeting on the Southbank Centre proposals held at 14 Baylis Rd (Waterloo Action Centre) hosted by Waterloo Community Development Group on 19<sup>th</sup> June, that you would be meeting with the Board of Governors on Monday the 1<sup>st</sup> of July.
