Dear Mike,

Thank you for your email dated 25th September which comes 10 days after the Open Forum weekend.

You state that you would 'like to extend once more our invitation to influence the design process for the alternative skate space'. What previous invitation do you refer to? As you are well aware – and as we have previously highlighted – you have been having private conversations with non-current users of the Undercroft while deliberately excluding Long Live Southbank from awareness of these discussions and any form of transparency.

You sent us your email at 6.59pm on your last day of work and requested the unreasonable task of responding within 24 hours. We have over 80,000 members whose position is for preservation not relocation.

You then ask that we contact Mark Rushworth without giving any indication of who he is, his position within the Southbank Centre and what his connection is to the matter in hand.

To avoid us seeing this as a deliberate tactic as part of an overall Southbank Centre derailing strategy, we request you do not continue to send us unreasonable and hasty demands that do not provide a respectful amount of time for responding.
